**Some of the riders & several of the club members got dressed up. Joe was chosen best costume! He hung out quietly in the woods & scared people as they stopped at the coffins.**

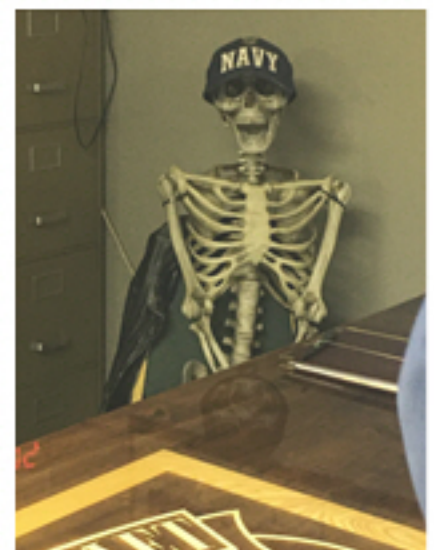

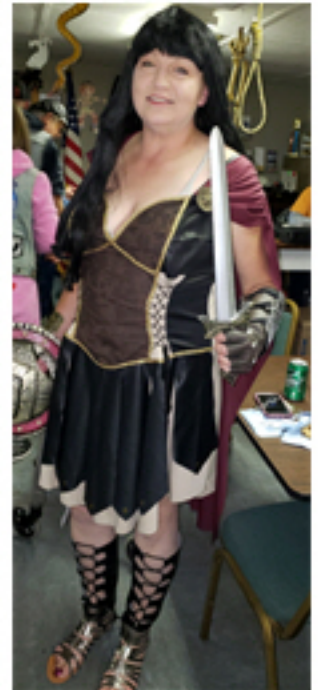
# Welcome to our combination Social Dinner/ Halloween Party!
