On Sat. 1/4, funeral services were held for Jason "Diesel" Dodd, former VP of BACA, who died suddenly on 12/27/19.



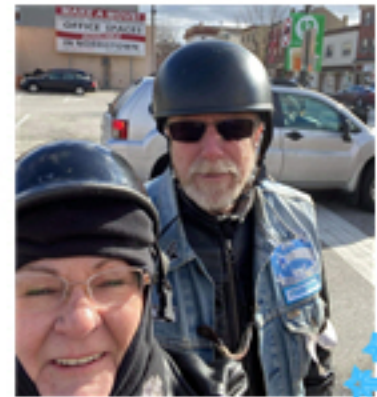
