6/5/2021 Some of our members joined Warrior Watch & Honor Flight in escorting a group of Veterans to the WWII Weekend at Reading Airport.

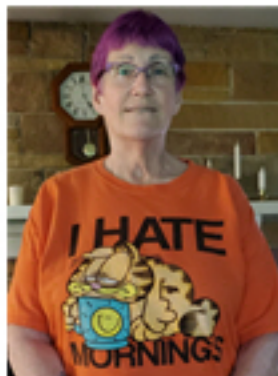




BINGO

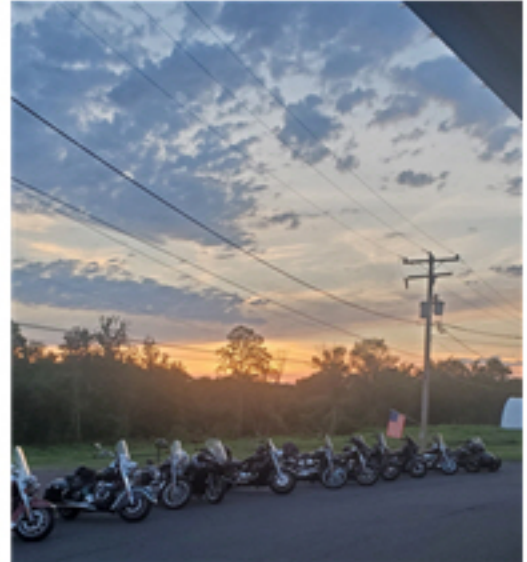

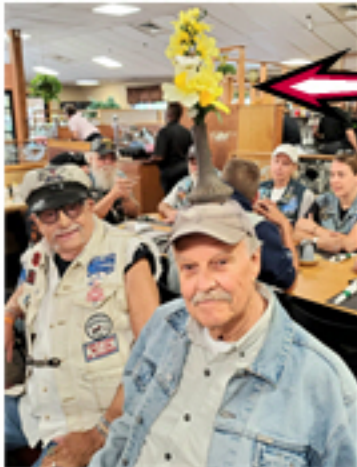
