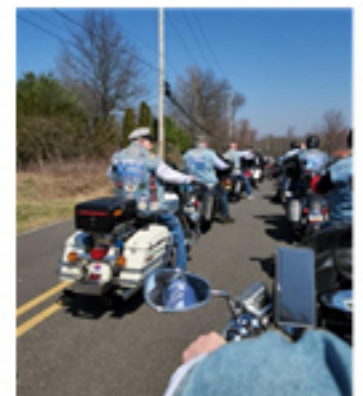
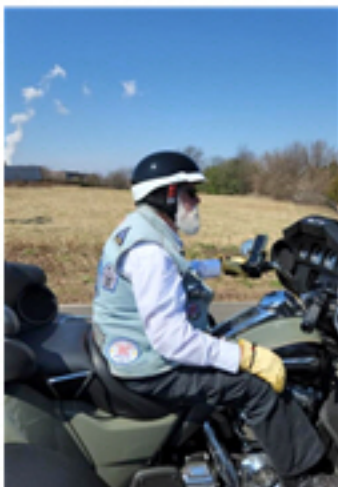

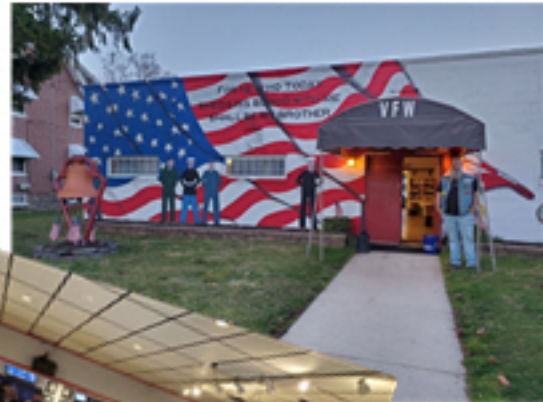
3/18 was Hang Out Night again!
